Dear Parents/Carers

As you are no doubt aware, the bulk of the GCSE examinations have been completed but are not over until the end of June. The Year 11 timetable is suspended with immediate effect.

Students should, however, continue to:

1. Attend lessons where examinations are not finished.
2. Attend BTec lessons to complete all work to a high standard.
3. Attend, as appropriate, the boosters/revision programme which will continue to run as published and students are encouraged to attend.
4. Wear full school uniform whilst on site.
5. Go off site when they do not have lessons/revision.
6. Sign in and out at Main reception for Health and Safety reasons.
7. Upkeep high standards of conduct, which are expected at all times.

Your support in encouraging students to continue to revise would be appreciated. A reminder about collection of results in August is detailed below.

Year 11 students can collect examination results from the Apollo Lower Plaza between **9.00am and 12.00pm on Thursday 25 August 2016**. A destinations questionnaire has to be completed and Post 16 interviews will take place in the Apollo Lower Plaza between 9.00am and 3.00pm. Students that have been offered a Post 16 place have already been given an appointment time.
