
As the cold weather approaches, I would like to remind parents that hoodies are not permitted in school. School jumpers and coats should be worn. Student planners contain all relevant information.

Early Closure – Wednesday 23 November 2016


Wilmington Academy's candidacy to become an International Baccalaureate World School, authorised to deliver the International Baccalaureate Careers Related Programme, has been accepted.
