These cards are essential for students to have as they provide students with information regarding their learning based on subject assessment in module 1. To develop student independence and pupils taking ownership of their learning, each student will have these to hand.

Staff will be ensuring that students can articulate the information on their card within lessons, form time and during mentor sessions. SLT will be quality assuring this process during learning walks and throughout the course of the academic year.

The cards show:

- (a) 'C' - Current grade and 'T' - Target grade for each subject.
- (b) KS2 fine point score
- (c) Average score across all subjects
- (d) Attendance

During college assemblies, Heads of College will be discussing the progress cards and the importance that these have on students' learning.

Cards will be updated at the start of each module and each student will have six in total by the end of the academic year on their key ring.

To ensure that collaboration between the Academy and parents/carers, it would be appreciated if you could discuss the information on the card with your son/daughter.
