Dear Parent/Carer

Year 8 and 9 PE High Achieving Pupil (HAP) trip to St George's Park

We have arranged to take a select group of year 8 and 9 PE HAP students to St George's Park (the training hub for the England football squad) to experience "the day in the life of a professional footballer". This wonderful opportunity will provide the students with a training session in state of the art facilities, a tour of the centre and a classroom based learning session with the aim to inspire and educate the pupils further into the science and lifestyle behind a professional sports performer.

We will be taking a coach to St George's Park, which will leave the Academy at 5:30am. As you can imagine we will be on a strict time schedule and so students will need to be at the Academy no later than 5:15am so that they can be registered and be ready to depart for 5:30am. We will arrive back at school for around 6:30pm subject to traffic so the students will need to bring a packed lunch on this day with either plenty of drink or a refillable drinks bottle.

Please note that we may, driver hours depending, stop off at a service station on the way. If this is the case then pupils will be allowed off the coach and into the service station where, if they wish to, may spend any pocket money they wish to bring. I do however stress that students should not be bringing excessive amounts of money on this trip.

As students will be participating in a coaching session taken by a FA affiliated coach, they will need to **wear their school PE Kit all day** (Polo shirt, black socks and black football socks) on the trip. Pupils will need to bring shin pads. They may also wear black or navy tracksuit trousers and a black or navy jumper to travel in / put on after the session. The session will be on a 3G surface and so trainers or boots with moulded studs may be worn. Students **will not** be able to participate in metal studs or without shin pads.

The cost of this trip will be £60 per student which includes the coach fare and "Ultimate football experience" ticket at St George's Park. In order to secure a place for your child we will require full payment by **31st March 2017** which can be paid in convenient instalments to yourself via your online ParentPay account. If you do not have access to the internet you will need to request a barcoded letter from the Apollo, Jupiter or Minerva College Admin Office,


as appropriate, to enable PayPoint payments. Please note that no payments can be made at school.

We would not wish to exclude any student from this trip for financial reasons. Please contact me in confidence if money is an issue.

Acceptance of the payment does not guarantee a place on the trip as we reserve the right to refuse a particular student a place on the grounds of poor behaviour or attitude. Students who are withdrawn from a trip as a result of poor behaviour may not be able to have their payment refunded in full and parents may be required to pay the full cost of the trip.

If you would like your child to participate in this visit I would be grateful if you could complete the attached reply slips and the medical consent form and return them, no later than **Friday 27th January 2017** so that I can guarantee your child a place.
