I am writing to inform you of the numerous events and opportunities that Year 11 Wilmington Academy students have access to in the lead up to their exams.

Year 11 Reward Programme - 'Reach for the Stars'

To motivate and engage students, a Year 11 raising standards student group have created a 12 week programme where all Year 11 students can achieve rewards for their effort in class, attendance at school and attendance at revision sessions.

The programme will start from module 4 and end on the last day of module 5. Teachers will award effort points to students in their classes which will then tally up into 'Stars'. The more stars a student receives, the more rewards they earn. 3 effort points equates to 1 star.

Rewards range from a 'Fast- Track' lunch pass, food, drinks, to vouchers or money off their Prom ticket.

- If a student attends an after school revision they receive a 0.5 effort point
- If a student has 100% attendance in each module they receive 2 stars.

Students can monitor their progress via a tracker found in the corridor next to the library from module 4.
