**Year 10 Catering and Year 10 Travel and Tourism Day trip to Brighton-23 May 2017**

We have planned a day trip for Year 10 Hospitality, Catering and Travel and Tourism students to visit Brighton on 23 May 2017.

Year 10 Catering Students will need to collect information on different eating and accommodation establishments. They need to investigate the nationalities that live/visit Brighton and check that they are catered for. This will enable students to be ready to design their own pop up restaurant for their coursework.

Year 10 Travel and Tourism Students will need to collect information from visitor attractions and see how they appeal to different visitor types as part of Travel and Tourism

The total cost of the trip will be £14 per person to cover the coach. Additional money will be needed to buy lunch we suggest approximately £15, this is optional as a packed lunch can be bought from home. Students will be encouraged to try different foods and be steered away from fast food outlets such as McDonalds and Subway.

**Outline of the day's programme:**

- Meet at Wilmington Academy at 8.30am
- Coach from Wilmington Academy to Brighton leaves at 9am
- Arrive In Brighton at 10.30
- 30 minute lunch in a chosen establishment Depart Brighton at 2.30pm
- Arrive at Wilmington Academy at 4pm approximately (depending on traffic)
- Students need to return their completed Consent Form to the Minerva Admin Office, upstairs in the Minerva plaza by 1 May 2017

Payment will need to be made through your ParentPay account by MONDAY MAY 1st 2017 please.


If you do not have access to the internet your child will need to request a bar-coded letter from the Apollo, Minerva or Jupiter College Admin offices, as appropriate to enable PayPoint payments.

Please note that no cash payments can be made at school. Current legislation permits us to ask only for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of a visit. No student will be discriminated against on the grounds of inability to pay. However, if sufficient money is not raised through contributions, then unfortunately this visit will have to be cancelled.

On the day, students will need to meet at Wilmington Academy at 8.30am We expect to return Wilmington Academy at 4pm Students must wear school uniform and be aware they will be outdoors most of the day so should bring a raincoat or sun cream as appropriate. It is advisable that students need to bring additional drinks and snacks for the day. Free school meals students will be provided with a packed lunch. There is some opportunity to purchase food, drink and souvenirs, but please, for safety reasons, we ask that students bring no more than the suggested £15 with them.
