
Parent Voice Meeting Thursday 4th May 2017





New Developments



- Reach for the Stars programme is in its ninth week and is having a positive effect on Year 11 classes. A number of rewards have been given.
- We had a visit from an Ofsted trained consultant on Thursday 26th & 27th May to assess our progress with our IBCP application. He observed 25 lessons and found the quality of teaching to be consistently good and outstanding in a significant minority of cases.
- We have moved to a new MIS system with Bromcom. There has been a thorough training programme for staff and it is now used in all lessons and for all admin.
- The Year 8 Options process is complete. All but 3 students have got their choices.

- Attendance is currently 95.1%.
- We are fully staffed in all subject areas. Mr Ryan Willington (Drama) and Mr Anthony Farr Junior (Head of Geography)took up their new posts and have made an impressive start.
- Our new mobiles are currently being installed and we hope to start using them after half-term.
- A new pathway is being constructed from Tredegar Road to a gate in the staff car park to avoid students crossing Common Lane on the dangerous bend.
