We are incredibly excited to announce that the FSB Skills 30:30 event is coming to Post 16 @ Wilmington Academy on Friday 30 June 2017!

As part of our 'Routes to Success' Week, Year 12 students will be given the opportunity to take part in the FSB Skills 30:30 event, which will offer them a real understanding about the world of work and employer expectations.

The event consists of a rapid fire series of interview style questions, which are designed to prepare students for interviews in the future. It will allow your son/daughter to grow accustomed to the stress of an interview situation in a safe environment, and develop skills which will see them thrive.
