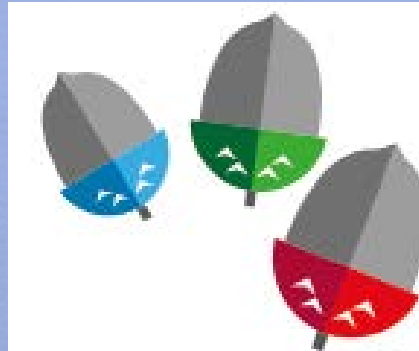

A.O.B.



1. Date of next meeting: Thursday 28th September 2017 6.00pm to 7.30pm
2. There was a robust discussion with the 24 families present at the meeting. Some parents were concerned about the shorter day. Key points explained at the meeting: We still teach over the government recommended teaching time. We have cut down movement around the school by having fewer but longer lessons. We have shortened tutor time to allow lessons to be longer. The lunch time is only 30 minutes long. We know that we can staff this curriculum for the next 3 years despite having no increase in our budget to cope with increases in salary costs.
3. A new 20mph speed limit for Common Lane is in place at last.
4. We are encouraging students to ride safely and to wear cycling helmets on their journeys to and from school.
5. A parent raised concerns about the 'harsh' wording of letters received for absences over 3 days. These are standard letters composed by the Local Education Authority and agreed by the Leigh Academies Trust.
6. Showmyhomework – Parents like this because it keeps them informed. They would like all staff to use it as effectively as the majority of the staff do. Mr Dedross to raise this at the next staff briefing.
7. The after school extra-curricular activities for all year groups will be published on the website next year.
