I am writing with regard to the forthcoming Year 11 Parents' Evening to be held on Wednesday 31 January 2018 from 4.00pm - 7.30pm.

Parents' Evenings are an opportunity for you to meet with all of your son/daughter's subject teachers and celebrate their success. Teachers at each appointment will discuss your son's/daughter's progress and agree individual targets to help your son/daughter achieve their potential. In addition, you can raise any concerns or address any subject-specific issues you may have. Attendance at events such as these are vitally important in helping students prepare as effectively as possible for their final examinations, and we ask that you make every effort to attend. Your son/daughter is not expected to wear school uniform to this event.

Students will receive their official mock results at this event. It is important that students view these results as an indication of what they could expect for the summer and think about whether these grades would ensure the admission criteria of their onward destination ie. Post 16, college, apprentice. The evening will also provide an ideal opportunity for parents to discuss these results in more detail with the teacher.

All students will be given an appointment sheet by their form tutor to record their appointments. Students must then see each subject teacher to agree an appointment time. (Appointments are allotted by teachers on a first-come, first-served basis. If you require specific timeslots, please encourage your son/daughter to see their teachers as soon as possible.)

In addition to the above opportunity to meet with the teaching staff, you may, of course, contact any member of the teaching staff via email or via your child's college Admin Office.
