Year 10 Mock examinations

We are preparing your child for the rigour and protocols of year 11 by undertaking formal mock examinations within some of your child's subjects. Your child has been prepared for both classroom based assessments and the formal exams. We ask for your support in ensuring they are preparing for their assessments/exams fully.

The Year 10 mock exam timetables are now available via My Child at School and for students via the student portal. All details of when and where your child will be sitting the exam can be found on these sites. These exams will be taking place from Monday 25 June to Monday 2 July. Students should be attending normal lessons when examinations are not taking place.

Morning exams start at 8:40am prompt.

Afternoon exams start at 1pm prompt - Students will need to go to 1st lunch if they have an afternoon exam.

It is important that students take these mock exams seriously, as it provides the Academy with essential information regarding their progress and targets for Year 11.

All students are required to bring the following in a clear pencil case for all exams

- Black pen, HB pencil, Ruler, Rubber, Sharpener, Highlighter
- Calculator - No lids
- Maths set (Protractor, Compass etc)

Students may also bring a bottle of water, in a clear bottle with no label.

All students must follow the JCQ exam regulations, these include the following:

Mobile phones, iPad, iPod/MP3 player, wrist watch or other data or communication device are strictly prohibited in any exam room.

No communication once entered the exam room - If assistance is required students must raise their hand and wait for a member of staff to assist.

Students are required to stay in the exam room for the entire examination until dismissed by a member of staff.
