Geography Fieldwork Trip – Wednesday 4 July (09y/Gg1 and 09y/Gg2)

The Geography Department has organised a field trip for Year 9 students as part of their GCSE. The cohort will be split across two days; 09y/Gg1 and 09y/Gg2 will attend the day trip on Wednesday 4 July 2018.

We will be visiting Westerham, Eynsford, Horton Kirby and Erith.

The aim of the field trip is aid students in their understanding of river landscapes which is a section in their Unit 1 exam. They will get into the river to measure different variables such as river width, depth and river load. This will be at 3 of the sites except Erith due to deep waters.

Students will need to bring along a packed lunch, money can be brought to buy from one of the village shops in Eynsford but these may not have anything suitable to eat. Own clothes should be worn but should be suitable for a field trip, NO hot-pants or belly tops. Wellington boots or suitable footwear that can get wet must be brought. The coach company will not allow anyone with wet clothes on the coach so please bring a change of clothes and additional footwear along with a strong carrier bag for any wet clothes/footwear.

We will be meeting at Wilmington Academy at 8.40am to travel by coach to the different locations and will return by 3.00pm in time for students to catch school buses or other modes of transport home. The cost of the trip is £15.00 and payment can be made via your child's ParentPay account. If you need a barcoded letter to pay by cash then please contact your child's college admin.
