HOSPITALITY AND CATERING

WJEC Level 1/2 Vocational Award in Hospitality and Catering

The qualification is designed as an introductory course for students interested in the Hospitality and Catering Industry. Students build on their practical skills developed in year 9 and 10 to produce more high level dishes for specific customers needs. Presentation skills and techniques are learnt to restaurant standards. Students practice the 9 hour controlled assessment to be fully aware of the expectation of the assessment that is undertaken in March/ April. Students also develop further their theory knowledge about the Hospitality and Catering Industry for the Unit 1 examination

How you will be assessed?

At the end of the course in Year 11:

A single on line examination one hour and thirty minutes in duration

The exam is worth 40% of the final overall grade

A nine hour Controlled Assessment consisting of written work , a production plan and cooking of two dishes

Key Stage 4 students are internally assessed in Catering at the end of each Module to monitor progress.
