



## **Year 9 - KS4**

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

During year 9 students will learn how to use the appropriate photographic processes and techniques with links to art. They will continue this throughout the year leading in to a series of mini projects.

They will explore photographic processes and techniques such as:

- DSLR Camera Settings.
- Lighting and Backdrops.
- The Triangle of Exposure; Aperture, Shutter Speed and ISO.
- Framing and Composition including; The Rule of Thirds, Leading Lines and Depth of Field.
- Various angles within photography.
- Photoshop techniques.
- Art basic techniques linked to photography.

Students will complete a series of mini projects around photographic processes and techniques including:

- How to use a camera guide.
- Miniature world through depth of field and macro lenses.
- Alphabet Project.
- Magazine Cover.
- Identity photo diary.
- Landscapes

Alongside various artist studies and art and photography based experimentation. This will include a variety of materials including powerpoint, painting, collage, printmaking and more.
