Careers Provision - what can you expect from us?

Our vision is to empower students to make inspirational, independent, impartial decisions by imparting knowledge of all future options within the confines of Career Education Information Advice and Guidance (CEIAG).

As part of the CEIAG provision, all students have a reflective log to explore their experiences of the careers education and advice they receive. Our careers education is delivered both discretely within lessons and as part of our pastoral programmes. Below is a list of events which each curriculum Key Stage can expect:
