Hastings Fieldwork trip – Tuesday 18 June 2019 (10y/Gg1, 10y/Gg2 and 10b/Gg1)

In order to help students with their GCSE exam, the Geography department have organised a trip to Hastings. The cohort will be split across two days; 10y/Gg1, 10y/Gg2 and 10b/Gg1 will attend the trip on Tuesday 18 June 2019.

This field trip will help them to meet the needs of Paper three, where they will be given the opportunity to collect data which they will then need to talk about in their exam. Students will develop knowledge on a range of data collection methods, as well help them to revise coastal management.

Students will need to bring along a packed lunch, or if preferred, money to buy lunch during the day. Own clothes should be worn but should be suitable for a field trip, NO hot-pants or belly tops. Suitable footwear for walking along a pebble beach must be brought (advise against sandals). Even though the weather forecast for this time may be warm, it is often chilly on the beach from the wind, so bringing a jacket just in case would be a good idea.

We will be meeting at Wilmington Academy at 8.40am to travel by coach to the different locations and will return by 3.00pm in time for students to catch school buses or other modes of transport home. The cost of the trip is £15.00 and payment can be made via your child's ParentPay account. If you need a barcoded letter to pay by cash then please contact your child's college admin.
