**Virus:** malware that can reproduce itself.



**Phishing:** scam to try and obtain personal details.



**Malware:** a computer program designed to cause harm

**Firewall:** electronic barrier which blocks unauthorised access to your computer.

**Copyright:** the creator of something has the right to say who can use it and how

**Copyright Free:** the author has given everyone permission to use.

**Royalty Free:** Can freely use without paying any additional money

Copyright is important because it protects the author from having their work distributed without their consent.
